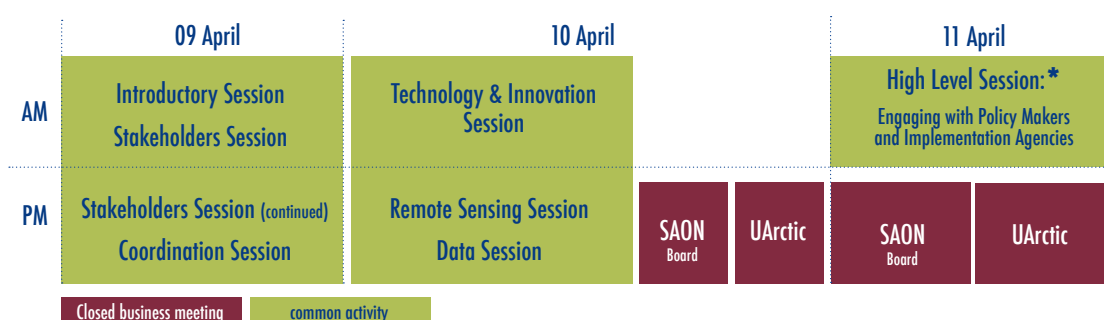


## Arctic Observing Summit 2014
