# MASTER DEGREE IN SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, GEOPOLITICS OF RESOURCES AND ARCTIC STUDIES 11th March – 30th October 2019

The Italian Society for International Organization, in agreement with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation, the Ministry of the Environment and Protection of Land and Sea and University of Rome UNITELMA Sapienza, organizes the Master Degree in Sustainable Development, Geopolitics of Resources and Arctic Studies. The aim of the Master is to develop skills and expertise in the areas of the green economy and the geopolitics of resources and energy, highlighting the eco-sustainability and a responsible use of the land. It will have a focus on the economic and geostrategic importance of the Arctic region.

#### **Objectives and subjects**

The course aims to develop professionals able to support national and international Institutions, the private sector and entrepreneurial activity, research institutions and, in general, all the organizations related to the energetic sector and the environmental management with aparticular specialization in fragile ecosystems like the Arctic one. This master is adressed to graduates of all academic fields, executives and functionaries of the civil and military Public Admistrations, officials from embassies, directors and commissionaires of the private sector, with a good knowledge of the English language.

#### **Master's Structure**

This course provides a formative activity that equals 200 unities of fron- tal didactic activities and 400 unities of individual studies and research. The lessons will take place from March until October on Mondays and Tuesdays from 2pm until 5pm. Furthermore, visits, meetings and workshops with agencies and mul-tinationals will be planned. These features will be hosted by Institu-tions and Corporations that operate in this sector.

- The consequences of plastic pollution in rhe oceans
- EFFECTS AND CONSEQUENCES OF CLIMATE CHANGES FROM THE ARCTIC TO MIDDLE LATITUDES
